THE GERANIUM COLLECTION

Geraniums or Cranesbills are hardy herbaceous plants. Most of them are easy to grow, being adaptable with respect to soil type, dry or damp positions, shade or sun. They flower over a very long season, some varieties beginning in April and some continuing till November, and of course, they come in a wide range of colour, whites, blues and pinks.

We have a large collection of Cranesbills growing here in the garden and many are available throughout the season in the Nursery, however, if a particular variety is not available in the display bed, then please do not hesitate to ask and we shall endeavour to grow it for you.
